1. Agenda – Tender competition and decision regarding publisher of Nordic Journal of Criminology

The Chair briefly presented the process and the three tenders submitted for the Nordic Journal of Criminology, as well as her recommendation of choosing Scandinavian University Press (see appendix 1-3 tender offers, appendix 4 tender comparison sheet, appendix 5 Memo from the Chair and appendix 6 Comments from the editor).

The recommendation was based on the fact that while the tenders do not differ greatly from each other, Scandinavian University Press offered the most competitive price.

The Council discussed whether there were any substantial, objective and qualitative reasons to continue publish with Taylor & Francis in accordance with the rules of a tender competition.

The decision was decided with a vote. 9 of the Council members voted in favour of Scandinavian University Press, 3 Council members voted in favour of Taylor & Francis.

Scandinavian University Press is the new publisher of Nordic Journal of Criminology.
